My dear Mr. Fanning:

Enclosed please find my check for \$14.45 to pay the taxes for the year 1935, on a piece of property standing in the name of R. F. Moseley in District 18. Please apply this against the taxes due on this property and send me a receipt made out in my name for the payment of these taxes.

I personally loaned Moseley some money, taking a mortgage on his property to secure the loan, and naturally wish to protect this loan.

I shall come down to see you within the near future regarding the taxes for 1936 and 1937, but I understand that the payment of the 1935 tax will prevent the property from going to sale for tax delinquency. Your attention to this matter will be appreciated.
